The remaining balance must be paid in full at least 75 days prior to the date of departure (April 25, 2025). An additional cancellation fee of \$1,000.00 applies for any cancellation received in writing between 149 and 75 days before departure. NO REFUND is possible under any circumstances for cancellations made within 74 days before departure. If 50% of the remaining balance is not received 145 days prior to departure, The Catholic Pilgrim Office (CPO) reserves the right, in its sole discretion to cancel the tour enrollment. Furthermore, to the fullest extent permitted by law, Participant hereby expressly releases, waives, and holds harmless, CPO, its owners, managers, agents, or employees for any liability for any damages or injuries, death, property damages, or all other losses whatsoever, sustained or incurred as a result of this Agreement. Please be advised that liability of carriers as well as providers of hotel and lodging accommodations is limited by law and Participants MUST purchase travel insurance to protect themselves against any losses or injuries suffered as a result of their acts and/or omissions. In no event shall CPO's liability exceed the amounts paid Participant for participation in the tour, subject to the provisions and cancellation fees herein. CHANGES: CPO reserves the right to withdraw the tour, reschedule departure, amend the itinerary, substitute hotels of comparable quality, and generally make any alteration or substitution if improvements can be made, operating requirements make it advisable, or unforeseen conditions beyond CPO's control make changes necessary. CPO reserves the right to accept or refuse any Participant whose actions, mental or physical condition impose upon or disturb other tour members or impede the operation of the tour. CPO's liability is limited to refund of the unused land services. DISPUTES: This Agreement shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia, without regard to conflicts of law principles. Venue shall be set in the State or Superior courts of Fulton County, Georgia. ATTORNEYS FEES: In the event a suit or action is filed to enforce this Agreement or with respect to this Agreement, the prevailing party or parties must be reimbursed by the other party for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the suit or action, including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees at the trial level and on appeal. MODIFICATIONS: Wherever possible, each provision of this Agreement shall be interpreted to be effective and valid under applicable law, but if any provision of this Agreement shall be prohibited by or invalid under applicable law, said provision shall be ineffective only to the extent of such prohibition or invalidity, without invalidating the remainder of such provision or the remaining provisions of this release. There shall be no amendment or modification of any of the terms of this Agreement unless it is reduced to writing and signed by all of the parties hereto.
