

Requirements for entering Spain if you are travelling from outside the EU/EEA

1. Whichever country you are arriving from, all passengers arriving in Spain by air or sea (ferry), including passengers making flight transfers and children under 12, must fill in a **health control form before they start their journey**. If you are arriving by plane, you can do this through the website <https://www.spth.gob.es/> or on the Spain Travel Health app for [Android](#) or [iOs](#) devices. If arriving by ferry, you must fill it in at the following link <https://spthm.puertos.es/> .

When you have filled it in, you will get a QR code which you must present both when boarding and when arriving in Spain. If you are arriving from a country/territory considered not to be a risk, you will get a FAST CONTROL QR code which will speed up the formalities when you arrive in Spain. **Please read the Spain Ministry of Health's website for more detailed information:**

Additionally, U.S. citizens who are traveling to Spain from a country that is not the United States should make sure they follow the guidance published by Spanish authorities on their local [Spain Embassy website](#) .

- Are PCR and/or antigen tests available for U.S. citizens in Spain? **Yes**
- If so, are test results reliably available within one calendar day? **Yes**

- U.S. citizens can obtain a COVID-19 test in Spain by paying an average of €30 for an antigen test, or €120 for a PCR test from a private medical facility, such as those on the [Covid Testing Locations list](#)
- Results are typically provided by email, but an original signed results record will be provided upon request.
